Dear Team Captain:

Thank you again for your help in making the 2018 Charlotte Dragon Boat Race and Asian Festival the best yet. We appreciate your efforts. This year we are launching a fundraiser, and we encourage to everyone to get involved. A portion of the proceeds benefits Charlotte Rescue Mission, who for over 80 years has been serving people struggling with addiction, poverty, or hopelessness with the goal of returning them to society as productive, self-sufficient citizens.

We are hoping each team will set a fundraising goal. The suggested goal is \$2,000, though you may set your own team's goal higher or lower. When a team member signs the online waiver, he or she will be added to the online peer-to-peer fundraising effort and receive an email from QGiv.com, our online fundraising provider.

Please note that this is a voluntary effort. Paddlers are under no obligation to raise any money, and choosing not to participate in the fundraiser will not affect their ability to race in any way.

That said, we hope many will choose to do so.

As Team Captain, you can set up your team's page in addition to your own individual page. General instructions on how to manage fundraising pages are included on a separate sheet. The instructions for the team page are similar. There, you can add a team logo, set your team goal, and keep track of how your team's fundraising effort is progressing. iF you need help send an email to fundraiser@charlottedragonboat.com. and we'll do our best to assist.

We hope that you will get excited about this new initiative. In addition to helping to offset the increasing costs of holding this wonderful event, the funds that are directed to Charlotte Rescue Mission will help people who have been struggling with addiction and homelessness to put their lives back together.

FUNDRAISING AWARDS

The Official Cutoff for determining who receives a fundraising medal is **May 31, 2018 at 11:59 p.m**.

Medal and award determinations will be made based on actual dollars contributed for each individual and each team at that time.

Awards Levels

Individual Medals

Fundraising Medal: \$100

Each individual who raises a minimum of \$100 by the Official Cutoff date will receive a medal.

Team Awards

Fundraising Medals: \$2,000

Each team that raises \$2,000 or more will receive a commemorative plaque.

Most Overall Donations

The team that raises the most overall donations at the time of the Official Cutoff will receive a special trophy.





CHARLOTTE RESCUE MISSION

First, learn about our charity partner. Founded in 1938, the Charlotte Rescue Mission has a long history of reaching out to the homeless and those battling addictions.

Rebound for Men

Rebound provides free Christian residential drug and recovery services for men who would not otherwise be able to afford such services. The program is modeled after the 12–Step Alcoholics Anonymous curriculum, but with one significant



difference; by providing clinical substance abuse counseling within a Christian context, **our program** completion rates are twice the national average.



While we provide food, clothing and shelter, it's always integrated within a minimum 120-day program. This multi-faceted approach ensures that our residents develop a deep understanding of their problems, including the root causes. In doing so, they learn not only how to cope with the pressures of staying drug and alcohol free, but how to manage the life scenarios that can trigger relapse. The 120-day program begins with 30 days of intense counseling and education, followed by 90 days of continued group and individual counseling, instruction and training.

Dove's Nest

Dove's Nest, Charlotte Rescue Mission's cost-free women's recovery program,

opened its doors in 1992 with a 12-bed residential home in the heart of historic Dilworth. Now, a new 120-bed facility on the city's west side provides a structured yet loving and stable living environment, with a dedicated staff aimed at helping women understand and deal with the core issues of addiction as a disease. The program welcomes mothers with their children and focuses on spiritual, physical, social and psychological recovery, to help women understand and deal with the core issues of their alcohol and/or drug addiction.




After the free 120-day intensive program, residents may opt for an eight-month extension in our continuing care division. The program is women-specific, with a staff dealing with all women's issues including mental, emotional, physical and sexual abuse, and a special team to assist with issues unique to mothers and their children. Our residents come to Dove's Nest to rest, mend, heal and gain a new direction in their lives.



This is the top portion of the Donation Page. The donation process is straightforward. Donors can choose to apply the donation on a participant's behalf. They can make a dedication. They can choose to make their name and their donation amount either public or anonymous. QGiv accepts VISA, MasterCard, and the Discover Card. If someone would like to write a check, they may do so and send it to:

If they write your name in the memo line, the amount will be added to your fundraising total when the funds have been deposited in the CDBA account. If a donor prefers to make a donation via PayPal, they may also do so.
